13.	Practice Range	<p>No practice range on-site</p> <p>There are six practice nets available for practice.</p> <p>There is a public driving range nearby and available for use at own cost. Caddies / Bag Carriers	<p><u>Practice Rounds (Monday & Tuesday):</u></p> <p>1 caddie to 1 player (NT\$2,080); 1 caddie to 2 players (NT\$1,580); 1 caddie to 3 players (NT\$1,380); 1 caddie to 4 players (NT\$1,280) Own caddie to pay NT\$50.00 for insurance Use of golf cart is NT\$450</p> <p><i>Note: Caddie fees need to be paid on a daily basis for practice rounds. All fees (caddie fees, insurance, and cart fees) must be paid, and the receipt presented to the starter before the start of practice.</i></p> <p><u>Tournament Rounds (Thursday to Sunday):</u></p> <p>NT\$2,380 per 18 holes (no shared caddie) Own caddie to pay NT\$50.00 for insurance Use of golf cart is NT\$450</p> <p><i>Note: Players are required to pay caddie fees for Rounds 1 and 2 during registration and the remaining fees for the final two rounds to be settled before the commencement of Round 3.</i></p> <p>REMINDER:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players who will bring own caddie MUST inform the Asian Tour by 31 Oct; otherwise, club caddie will be assigned and MUST be paid for. • Deadline for club caddie booking: 31 Oct • No cancellation of club caddies will be entertained after Nov 8. Any player cancelling the club caddie booking will be charged 2 practice rounds + 2 tournament rounds. <p>Players who use club caddies for Rounds 1 & 2 are still required to pay caddie fees should you want to use your own caddie for Rounds 3 & 4.</p> <p>All players are required to fill out the caddie information form via the following link: Taifong Open - Caddie Request Form</p>

26.	Special Tournament Regulations	Distance Measuring Devices (without elevation/slope information) are PERMITTED to be used during practice, Pro-Am & tournament rounds. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance ONLY. If during a tournament round, a player uses a Distance Measuring Device with any elevation/slope function enabled, the player is in breach of Rule 4.3. Penalty for Breach of Rule 4.3: First Breach: General Penalty; Second Breach: Disqualification
